ANSWER KEY FOR LEVEL C — CRITTER CHALLENGE

INSTRUCTIONS: Using pages 1 through 28 of the book, count the number of critters in each of the categories listed below.

NOTE: Ruby Lee is not counted as a critter, but critter-shaped containers are counted.

1) Ants

There are fifteen ants - three ants are found on each of these pages: 7, 9, 17, 20 and 27.

2) Bees

There are nine bees (not including Ruby Lee, but including the bee-shaped honey pot).

There are two bees on page 1, one bee on page 4, three bees on page 5, two bees on page 6 and one bee on page 8.

3) Beetles

There are six beetles - one on each of these pages: 1, 4, 11, 14, 21 and 24.

4) Birds

There are twelve birds: three on page 2, three on page 3, three on page 6, two on page 9, and one on page 27.

5) Bunnies

There are eight bunnies: three on page 1, three on page 5, one on page 25, and one on page 28.

6) Butterflies

There are twenty-five butterflies: four on page 2, two on page 3, three on page 10, five on page 11, one on page 12, three on page 13, six on page 14, and one on page 22.

7) Caterpillars

There are three caterpillars - one on each of these pages: 4, 14 and 24.

8) Dragonflies

There are five dragonflies - one on each of these pages: 6, 9, 16, 19 and 26.

9) Frogs

There are four frogs: two on page 6, one on page 7 and one on page 22.

10) Katydid/Grasshoppers

There are three katydids/grasshoppers - one on each of these pages: 5, 15 and 25.

11) Ladybugs

There are three ladybugs - one on each of these pages: 8, 18 and 28.

12) Moles/Groundhogs

There is one mole/groundhog on page 24.

13) Praying Mantises

There is one praying mantis on page 16.

14) Garden Signs

There are three garden signs - one on each of these pages: 3, 5 and 28.

15) Snails and Slugs

There are four snails and slugs - one on each of these pages: 7, 10, 14 and 20.

16) Spiders

There are three spiders - one on each of these pages: 3, 13 and 23.

17) Squirrels

There are three squirrels. They are all found on page 6.

18) Turtles

There are three turtles - one on each of these pages: 1, 2 and 4.
